- Multidisciplinary perspectives in forensic evaluations
- Ethical aspects linked to the use of AI in the forensic field
- AI applications in prediction of aggression and violence
- AI and its implications in guilt, punishment, and responsibility
- AI-based systems to support personal injury compensation.

#### Submission types

The following types of submissions are solicited:

1. Abstracts of oral presentations
2. Abstracts to be presented in the poster session
3. Proposals of thematic sessions, including the abstracts of 4–5 oral presentations on a related topic. Those who organize one or more accepted sessions will be added to the Scientific Programme Committee.

- After the conference, authors will be invited to submit a full article on the topics of their presentation for possible publication in an article collection to appear in [Elsevier International Journal of Law and Psychiatry](#). Prospective authors will be given details after the conference.
